Species Data Sheet

Paphiopedilum adductum Asher, Orchid Digest 47: 224 (1983)

[Paff-ee-oh-PEH-di-lum add-DUC-tum]

A Philippine small sized, cool growing, epiphytic / terrestrial species found in leaf litter around 1250 to 1350 meters on Mindanao Island in Bukidnon Province near Impasugong. Typically it has six, oblong-ligulate to slightly lanceolate, dark green leaves, 23-26 cm [9-10 in.] long by 3.9-4.2 cm [1.5-1.7 in.] wide, have a translucent margin. It blooms in the early winter on an erect to arching, terminal, 8 - to 14" [20 - 34 cm] long, 2 - 3 to several flowered, arching pubescent purple inflorescence with green veined maroon floral bracts. The flowers open simultaneously. Flowers more or less glabrous (hairless), 2.3 – 3.5 in. [5.9 – 9 cm] across, 5.5 – 7.1 in. [14–18 cm] tall; sepals pale greenish yellow or white, strongly maroon-veined, dorsal sepal arching; petals pale yellow, spotted with maroon in basal half, maroon in apical half, arcuate-dependent, lineartapering acute, 3.1 – 5.9 in. [8–15 cm] long, apically finely pubescent; pouch pale yellow, mottled and veined purple on front of slipper, porrect (extend horizaontally); staminode yellow with purple glands, rectangular, notched at apex, hairy on sides. In recent years, hybrids using this species and its variety anitum with other closely related multifloral species have proven themselves to be very popular. The species is variable regarding the numer of flowers on an inflorescence and the flower size. A curious observation on this species is worth recounting, the tissue between the stripes in the dorsal sepal is relatively transparent so that when this structure is viewed with the sun behind it, the dark stripes make quite a contrast. No doubt this helps bring the flower to the pollinator's attention.

Varieties / forms:

Paphiopedilum adductum var. anitum – The darkest forms of this species, darker flowers (especially the dorsal sepal) and leaves (slightly more glaucous). This variety is preferred for hybridizing. An examination of staminodes in the two forms did not reveal major differences.

Breeding Characteristics:

Paphiopedilum adductum has 135 progeny with 95 being first generation. I was not able to find any breeding information on Paph. adductum but by reviewing pictures of some of the progeny I detected the following: the porrect lip (horizontally extend), long narrow flat petals, and veination to overlaid sepals and petals does appear in many of the progeny.
