This is a mini growing plant with nice sized flowers that grows well in this area. It is coerulea (blue) and peloric (the petals are mimicking the lip).

These plants, though on the small side, are all old enough to bloom, if they haven't already. They were obtained in 2014 from Carmela Orchids, Inc. as a plug.


This plant was purchased from The OrchidWorks as a plug in 2017 and has been growing happily during summer and winter under shade cloth.




#### Cattleya intermedia var. alba f. peloric

Species Orchid

Found in central to southern Brazil, Uruguay and Argentina in the Atlantic coastal forest where it is found on rocks and small trees near the sea or streams as a small to medium sized, cool to warm growing orchid that blooms in the spring or summer. It is fragrant and enjoys life protected by 50% shade.

These were obtained from The OrchidWorks in July of 2017 as plugs.



#### Rlc. Robert's Choice x Lc. Carl Bornshine 'Mendenhall'

Hybrid

This is a cross between the above shown orchid plants. It was purchased from The OrchidWorks as a plug in 2017 and has been growing happily outdoors during summer and winter under shade cloth.



#### C. Horace 'Maxima' AM/AOS x Rlc. (Oconee 'Mendenhall' x Sunset Sail) 'Paradise'

#### Hybrid

This is a cross between the above shown orchid plants. It was purchased from The OrchidWorks as a plug in 2017 and has been growing happily outdoors during summer and winter under shade cloth.



#### C. guttata var. coerulea ('Keiko' x 'Sergio')

Species Orchid

This is a medium sized, cool to warm growing epiphyte or lithophyte which prefers 50% shade and has fragrant flowers. This species needs a distinct dry winter rest which in turn will bring about blooming.

It was obtained from H & R Nurseries as a compot in April of 2016.



#### SIc. Seagull's Apricot 'Glorious' AM/AOS x Pot. Sunday Jewel

Hybrid

This is a cross between the above shown orchid plants. It was purchased from The OrchidWorks as a plug in 2016 and has been growing outdoors happily during summer and winter under shade cloth.

## Lc. Maui Plum 'Volcano Queen' AM/AOS

(Cattleya guttata x Cattleya Summerland Girl)

Hybrid

Mericlone

This orchid has been growing outside in our area for five years and is growing vigorously under shade cloth.

It was obtained from Carmela Orchids, Inc. as a plug in 2014.



#### RIc. Elegant Dancer 'Rouge' x RIc. (Oconee x Sunset Sails') 'Paradise Bird'

Hybrid

This is a cross between the above shown orchid plants. It was purchased from The OrchidWorks as a plug in 2017 and has been growing happily outdoors during summer and winter under shade cloth.



#### Laelia perrinii

Species Orchid

This plant is native to Brazil. It is a medium sized, warm to cool growing, epiphytic orchid that blooms in the late summer through the winter with 2 to 6, long-lasting 5 inch flowers. It likes 50% shade and grows well in our area.

It was obtained in 2017 from The OrchidWorks as a plug.



#### Pot. Mario Lanzo x Pot. William Farrell 'Pastel Parade'

Hybrid

This is a cross between the above shown orchid plants. It was purchased from Carmela Orchids, Inc. as a plug in 2014 and has been growing outdoors happily during summer and winter under shade cloth.



**Pot. Tropical Orange 'Apricosa'** (Rhyncholaeliocattleya William Farrell x Rhyncattleanthe Orange Nuggett)

> Hybrid Mericlone

This orchid has been growing outside in our area for five years and is growing vigorously under shade cloth.

It was obtained from Carmela Orchids, Inc. as a plug in 2014.



#### C. skinneri alba x self

Species Orchid

From Chiapas state of Mexico to Costa Rica as a medium sized, bifoliate epiphyte where it is found in humid forests on tree trunks and branches or terrestrial-lithophyte on granite cliff banks at altitudes of 200 to 2300 meters that blooms in the winter through spring and occasionally in the fall

This species likes to be mounted on wood and is a warm to cool growing species and is the national flower of Costa Rica. They like a dry winter rest and will bloom from brown or green sheaths that were formed the summer before. They are fragrant and enjoy 50% shade.

They have been growing outdoors, locally, since 2017 and came from The OrchidWorks.




#### Oncidium sphacelatum

#### Species Orchid

This is a warm to hot growing epiphyte that grows well in this area under approximately 75% shade conditions. It blooms in the spring with spikes that can reach 6 feet in length, with lateral to pendulous panicles that can carry many flowers. The flowers are faintly fragrant.

Please Note: This plant will also be available in pots for you to carry home and keep as they are, or to transplant into larger pots as a good start toward the specimen plant you see above.



#### Blc. Norman's Bay 'Lowe's' FCC/AOS x Lc. Ann Akagi Ihihimanu' HCC/AOS

Hybrid

This is a cross between the above shown orchid plants. It was purchased from The OrchidWorks as a plug in 2016 and has been growing happily outdoors during summer and winter under shade cloth.



#### Slc. Circle of Life 'Strawberry Moon' x Pot. John Passander 'Goldilocks'

Hybrid

These plants have been living outdoors winter and summer under shade cloth and were obtained from The OrchidWorks in 2017.



#### Yamadara Orchidom Green Glade 'Shungetsu'

Hybrid

This is an intermediate grower that likes indirect lighting and blooms in the spring – fall.

They have been growing outdoors, locally, for the past several years and came from The OrchidWorks.



#### C. harrisoniae 'Homestead' x Cattleya harrisoniae

#### Species Orchid

Found in southeastern Brazil as a epiphytic or lithophytic, cool to warm growing species occurring in humid swampy areas on bushes and blooms in the late summer on a terminal, short to 4", few to several [2 to 6] flowered inflorescence subtended by a green sheath carrying fragrant, long-lived, waxy flowers.

This species and C. loddigesii are very similar yet differ in this species having darker and unscented flowers.

This species needs ample water, warmth and light while growing and a good rest after maturity.

These plants were obtained from Carter & Holmes Orchids in 2016 and have been living outdoors winter and summer under shade cloth.



#### **Oncidium sphacelatum**

Species Orchid

This is a warm to hot growing epiphyte that grows well in this area under approximately 75% shade conditions. It blooms in the spring with spikes that can reach 6 feet in length, with lateral to pendulous panicles that can carry many flowers. The flowers are faintly fragrant.

These are good sized plants and could sport several spikes at blooming time.



#### Cattleya bowringiana var. coerulea x self

Species Orchid

Belize and Guatemala are the home to this medium to large sized, hot to warm growing lithophyte found at elevations of 210 to 900 meters and blooms in the fall. It likes 50% shade.

These plants were obtained from TheOrchidWorks in June of 2017 as plugs and are still on the small size but should start growing rapidly now.



#### Cattleya intermedia var. alba f. peloric

Species Orchid

Found in central to southern Brazil, Uruguay and Argentina in the Atlantic coastal forest where it is found on rocks and small trees near the sea or streams as a small to medium sized, cool to warm growing orchid that blooms in the spring or summer It is fragrant and enjoys life protected by 50% shade.

These were obtained from The OrchidWorks in July of 2017 as plugs. They are a little on the small side but should be ready to take off this year.



#### C. schilleriana (4n) x C. schilleriana (4n)

Species Orchid

Found in Brazil as a small sized, cool to hot growing, epiphytic, bifoliate orchid growing on hardwood thickets on cliff faces at elevations of sea-level. This species blooms in the summer and fall on a 1 to 5 flowered inflorescence carrying fragrant, waxy flowers.

These were obtained from H&R Nurseries in 2017. They are a little on the small side but should be ready to take off this year.



#### C. amethystoglossa ('HR Super Spots' 4n x 'Big Spots' 4n)

#### Species Orchid

Found in Bahia, Minas Gerais and Pernambuco states of Brazil as a large sized, cool to warm growing epiphyte at elevations around 600 meters that blooms in the fall, winter and early spring with a terminal, several to many [10 to 30] flowered inflorescence carrying fragrant flowers.

This species needs ample light, water and fertilizer while growing and a definite rest when in dormancy.

This species is very similar to C guttata yet differs in the flowers which here are white or pale rose, spotted dark rose or mauve on the sepals and petals and the lip has white lateral lobes, a magenta midlobe and a pale golden or white throat.

They were obtained from H&R Nurseries in 2017.
