Bulbophyllum Hsinying Grand-arfa	BS	30	<i>(Bulb. grandiflorum x Bulb. arfakianum) Large, stunning ,unusual flowers. The hybrid is not only easier to grow than the parents, but it also produces more colourful burgundy-chocolate flowers.</i>
Bulbophyllum levanae v. levanae 'Outhouse'	BS	30	<i>Amazing gold and red open flowers with a scent that is noted in its clonal name.</i>
Bulbophyllum longiflorum 'Crownfox' CCM/AOS	BS	25	<i>Whorls of cream flowers speckled and suffused dark burgundy on vigorous plants.Spectacular!</i>
Bulbophyllum medusae	BS	35	<i>Long pure white flower presented in big shaggy umbel.s Looks more like Cousin IT than the goddess Medusa to me.</i>
Bulbophyllum phalaenopsis	BS	105	<i>Long leathery leaves make these impressive plants all year round. The hairy reddish flowers are stunning and arresting. The strong sent is not to be ignored. Fortunately, it is wafted only at certain times.</i>
Bulbophyllum purpurascens	BS	30	<i>Cute miniature plants with oversized mop-head like cream flowers that are as big as the individual growths.</i>
Bulbophyllum taiwanense	BS	30	<i>Warm growing miniature with elegant rusty-orange flowers in early spring</i>
Bulbophyllum vaginatum	BS	30	<i>Long light-yellow flowers form stunning shaggy umbels on small sized plants</i>

Brassavola nodosa 'Susan Fuchs' FCC/AOS	BS	30	<i>Lady of the night. Select large white flowers. Very fragrant at night. Bright light.</i>
Cattleya (Laelia) purpurata f. schusteriana	BS	40	<i>Huge white flowers with deep purple lips. Very fragrant.</i>

Cattleya warscewiczii 'Our Tropics'	BS	35	Also known as giga. Soft pink petals and sepals with magenta lip showing a pair of yellow eyes.
Epidendrum polybulbon 'Sunset'	BS	25	Small creeping plant that quickly forms a large mat. Sepals and petals are yellow green to bronze. Lots of stellate, long-lasting, fragrant flowers.
Epidendrum porpax	BS	25	Miniature that quickly grows into a mat. Unusual red flowers that are large for the size of the growths. Does well mounted.
Epidendrum schectermanum	BS	25	Miniature that quickly grows into mats and covers itself with green flowers. Does very well mounted
Rhyncholaelia digbyana	BS	40	Highly fragrant ice-green flowers with deeply fringed lip. High light
(C. Caudebec 4n 'Linwood' AM/AOS x C. Mark Jones 'Lance')	BS	35	Amethyst spotted, full, fragrant flowers on compact plants. Should produce 7-9 flowers when mature.
(C. Comets Tail 'Super Nice' x C. aclandiae 'Kathleen III' AM/AOS	BS	40	Dark gold, fragrant, heavy textured flowers with lots of magenta spots and magenta lip. Very like the aclandiae parent. These compact plants are summer blooming.
Brassocattleya Nakornpathome Silver (Bc. Binosa x B. nodosa)	BS	30	(Bc. Binosa x B. nodosa) Green stars with large white magenta spotted lips. Fragrant
<u>Cattleya Aloha Case f. alba</u>	BS	30	<u>(C. Mini Purple x C. walkeriana)</u> Beautiful snow-white flowers on compact easy to bloom plants. Fragrant
Cattleya Candy Sparks	BS	30	Brilliant round orange flowers on miniature plants. Central yellow flash lights up the entire flower like the sun. Each one different. Each one gorgeous. ( Mem Trudy Marsh x Angel Fantasy)
<u>Cattleya Orglade's Grand</u>	BS	30	<u>(C. Mildred Rives x C. Persepolis)</u> Huge full, pure white flowers with stunning with deep magent lip. Fragrant. Truly a classic Cat.
Cattlianthe Chocolate Drop	BS	30	This old favorite produces great heads of long-lasting red waxy flowers more than once a year.
Cattlianthe <u>Sagarik Wax 'African Beauty' AM/AOS</u>	BS	30	<u>(C. Summerland Girl x Ctt. Chocolate Drop)</u> Heads of waxy rich red flowers. Stunning
<u>Guarechea Black Comet (Grc. Miva Etoile Noire x Psh. cochleata)</u>	BS	40	Red purple cockleshell shaped flowers. Very unusual colour and shape. Easy to grow and flower
Laeliocattleya (Lc. C.G. Roebing 'Beachview' AM/AOS x Lc. Love Knot 'SVO' HCC/AOS)	BS	35	This cross of the beautiful large flowered standard with a mini produces mid sized plants with lots large blue flowers.
Laeliocattleya Mini Blue Star (Lc. Mini Purple f. coerulea '4N' x Lc. Cornelia f. coerulea 'Floralia')	BS	35	Expecting 3-4" coerulea flowers with darker coerulea lips on plants just 6-7" tall
Potinara (Pot. Elaine Taylor 'Krull-Smith' FCC/AOS x Pot. Lebenkries 'Diamond Orchids')	BS	35	These will be compact-growing plants that mature at around 10" tall. Expect superb flower shape with intense red colors and very dark, full burgundy lips on plants that bloom twice a year.

Cycnoches warscewiczii	BS	45	<i>The Swan Orchid. Huge swan shaped bright green flowers with white lips. Very attention getting.</i>
(Ctsm. Dark Tale 'Black Surprise' x Ctsm. Ryan Harrington 'Best of the Best')	BS	60	<i>This is the best of solid black breeding. So if you are looking for dark flowers, this one is for you</i>
(Ctsm. Orchidglade 'Davie Ranches' AM/AOS x Ctsm. Memoria Raúl Mortera Penedo 'Great Lips')	BS	50	<i>We expect large flowers with flat lips, densely spotted in red burgundy on a lighter background. These mini-Catasetums will be easy to grow and flower. Should bloom throughout the growing season.</i>
Catasetum Corinne's Frilly Spots	BS	50	<i>(Ctsm. Frilly Doris 'SVO II' AM/AOS x Ctsm. tigrinum 'Very Wide Petals' The tigrinum reduces the plant size. We expect high flower count, spotted flowers and frilly lips with great shape.</i>

Cycnoches Richard Brandon	BS	60	<i>This is a sib cross of the best clones of this robust growing grex. Colour will vary, but will be spotted. All will be gorgeous. Some will be exceptional</i>
Fredclarkeara After Dark 'Black Pearl'	BS	50	<i>(Morm. Painted Desert x Ctsm. Donna Wise) These stunning flowers are about as black as they can be.</i>

Coelogyne cristata	BS	30	<i>This species is worth growing just for the shinny ball shaped pseudobulbs. The white, crystalline, often fragrant flowers are a great bonus in late winter.</i>	
Coelogyne flaccida 'Sunset Blaze'	BS	25	<i>Very easy to grow to specimen size. Very fragrant cream-coloured flowers. Spring blooming.</i>	
Coelogyne huetneriana var lactea	BS	25	<i>Similar to flaccida. Slightly larger plants with the flowers emerging higher above the foliage. Fragrant. Often called 'the milk white coelogyne'</i>	
Coelogyne Orchidengarten Joachin	BS	30	<i>This hybrid that stays in bloom for many months. Deep orange to black lips with salmon sepals and petals. (usitana x salmonicolor)</i>	
Coelogyne pandurata	BS	30	<i>These grow into large plants that produce long stems of brilliant light green flowers with black lips with each new growth. Definitely worth the space. Showtopper!</i>	
Coelogyne speciosa 'Mint Daiquiri'	BS	30	<i>Medium sized plants that produce fairly long-lasting sequentially opening flowers. Mildly musk scented. This one has green sepals and petals with the usual white tipped dark brown lip.</i>	
Coelogyne speciosa 'Salmon'	BS	30	<i>We like this species so well we grow it in several colour forms. This one is light salmon.</i>	
Coelogyne speciosa 'Sunrise Explosion'	BS	30	<i>And this one is the yellow form.....</i>	
Coelogyne swaniana	BS	30	<i>Pendent inflorescences of clear white flowers with brown patterned lips. Slight musky scent.</i>	
Coelogyne tomentosa	BS	25	<i>Medium plant with pendant inflorescences. Spotted lip very attractive. (syn massangeana)</i>	
Coelogyne trinervis	BS	25	<i>Medium size plant. White with red-brown lip. Fragrant.</i>

<u>Dendrobium jenkinsii</u>	BS	30	<i>Miniature mounted plants that produce bright yellow flowers with fringed lips after a cool dry winter rest.</i>	
<u>Dendrobium jydii</u>	BS	26	<i>New dendrobium species. White flowers on medium plants. Very pretty.</i>	
<u>Dendrobium lindlyi</u>	BS	30	<i>A larger version of the above species which produces longer inflorescences of bright yellow flowers after a cool, dry winter rest.</i>	
Dendrobium linguiforme	BS	30	<i>Succulent leafed alternating growths. White fragrant flowers. Miniature usually grown mounted.</i>	

	Dendrobium prenticei	BS	25	<i>Tiny succulent plants. Cream flowers with orange lips. Mounted</i>
	Dendrobium parishii	BS	30	<i>Multi caned plants that produce pretty bright pink flowers with a contrasting dark eye.</i>
	<u>Dendrobium Bella Maree</u>	BS	30	<i>(Den. Dawn Maree x Den. bellatulum)_Bellatulum parent prevents these from getting too tall. The same long-lasting white flowers with brilliant red-orange lips</i>
	Dendrobium Hibiki	BS	30	<i>(Den. bracteosum x Den. laevifolium) Hot pink flowers are produced on old canes over and over again. Remains in flower for months. Compact plants</i>
	<u>Dendrobium Rainbow Fantasy</u>	BS	25	<i>The shades of pink flushed over white flowers give hybrid its name.</i>
	<u>Dendrobium Hilda Poxon</u>	BS	25	<i>(Den. tetragonum x Den. speciosum) Fragrant yellow stars with lots of burgundy spots. Quite unusual.</i>
	<u>Dendrobium Rainbow Dance</u>	BS	20	<i>(Den. Kurenai x Den. unicum) Compact plants with lots of long-lasting pink flowers. Easy to flower.</i>

	Dendrochilum bicallosum 'Pink Agate'	BS	25	<i>Beautiful spirals of pink-coral cascades on small well behaved plants.</i>
	Dendrochilum cobbianum 'Porcelain'	BS	25	<i>Long light gold arching chains with slight musky sent. Very nice display.</i>
	Dendrochilum filiforme 'King Midas'	BS	25	<i>Delicate, bright yellow chains on compact plants. Easy to grow and Flower on many arching stems.</i>
	Dendrochilum javierianum 'Super Mario'	BS	25	<i>Bright Yellow brushes on terete leafed plants</i>
	Dendrochilum magnum 'P.I'	BS	30	<i>Long elegant streamers of cream flowers. The largest of the genus</i>
	Dendrochilum propinquum 'Coral Tresses'	BS	25	<i>Stunning displays of spiraled cascades of coral flowers on this midsized plant. A must have.</i>

	Brassia Rex 'Goliath'	BS	30	<i>Huge yellow fragrant spiders</i>

	Brassidium Yellow Star	BS	25	<i>Yellow, chocolate marked stars on compact plants.</i>
	Bratonia Purple King	BS	35	<i>(Brat. Charles M.Fitch x Milt Purple Queen) Purple spotted spiders. Stunning!</i>
	Oncidium Golden Afternoon	BS	40	<i>Long sprays of yellow, chestnut barred 'dancing ladies'. Lips (skirts) nicely contrasting white.</i>

	Paphiopedilum bellatulum	BS	40	<i>Big round white flowers heavily spotted with wine. Stunning.</i>
	Paphiopedilum delanatii	BS	40	<i>White, pink flushed slipper with darker pink pouch. Only Paph that is fragrant</i>
	Paphiopedilum glaucophyllum	BS	45	<i>White, green, and maroon slippers with short twisted petals that are produced sequentially over many, many months.</i>
	Paphiopedilum rothschildianum	BS	80	<i>The king of all Paphs. Magnificent flowers. Multifloral</i>
	Paphiopedilum Magic Lantern	BS	40	<i>(micranthum x delanatii) Pretty light to dark pink bubbles.</i>
	Paphiopedilum Gloria Naugle	BS	75	<i>(rothschildianum x micranthum) Stunning multifloral. Lots of dark maroon stripes on a light green base.</i>
	Paphiopedilum Hsinying Beam x Hsinying Mishima	BS	25	<i>This cross has beautiful mottled leaves. Easy to grow. This cross will produce mostly pure green and white flowers.</i>
	Paphiopedilum Hung Sheng Bay x Hung Shen	BS	25	<i>Lovely mottled leaves producing a beautiful slipper in various combinations of red, green, and white. Some will be solid red vinis. Every one will be different with unique variegated foliage. Great starter slippers.</i>
	Paphiopedilum Hung Sheng Jupiter	BS	65	<i>(Benkei x rothschildianum) Usually 2 -3 large white flowers reticulated burgundy. Stately</i>
	Paphiopedilum Hung Sheng Langur	BS	55	<i>(Lady Isabel x Hung Sheng Eagle) Large flowered multifloral. Stately, stunning, spectacular.</i>
	Paphiopedilum Mem Larry Heuer	BS	45	<i>(malipoense x emersonii) Huge art shade slippers. Absolutely stunning</i>

	Paphiopedilum Volcano Goddess	BS	75	<i>(Yang-Ji Apple x rothschildianum) 3-4 Deeply coloured magnificent flowers. Plants are vigorous growers</i>
	<b>PHRAGMIPEDIUM</b>			
	Phragmipedium humboldtii 'Fortuna'	BS	95	<i>Large dark chocolate and red flowers with extremely long twisted petals. 50cm plus long.</i>
	Phragmipedium warszewiczianum var wallisii	BS	75	<i>Stately green and white flowers with long twisted petals that keep growing as long they don't touch any surface.</i>
	Phragmipedium Elizabeth March	BS	55	<i>(Sedenii x besseae) compact plants with lovely pink and White flowers</i>
	Phragmipedium Fireworks	BS	55	<i>(Grande x pearcei) The pearcei parent has brought down the size of the plant. Even with shorter petals than Grande the flowers are still majestic.</i>
	Phragmipedium Fritz Schomburg	BS	75	<i>One of the best of the kovachii hybrids. Good grower and huge magenta to orange flowers ( kovachii x besseae)</i>
	Phragmipedium Hanne Popow	BS	50	<i>Reliable, easy grower with sequentially opening flowers in pink to orange to bicolor tones. (schlimii x besseae)</i>
	Phragmipedium Mini Grande	BS	75	<i>Smaller growing Phrag. with stately long twisted petals. (humboldtii x pearcei) Multi growth plants.</i>
	Phragmipedium Predator 4N	BS	75	<i>This long petaled hybrid has the advantage of two highly coloured parents. ( richteri x humboldtii) These flowers are gorgeous! Multi-growth plants</i>
	Phragmipedium QF Maria	BS	60	<i>(lindleyanum x dalessandroi) Good grower producing impressive branched inflorescences with brilliant orange red flower.</i>
	Phragmipedium Saint Owen	BS	60	<i>(Hanne Popow x besseae) With extra dose of besseae the colours are more spectacular and the flowers rounder. Some of these are coming out bicolor – yellow and red.</i>
	Phragmipedium Zapatilla de la Virgen	BS	105	<i>Deeply coloured with extremely long petals. Stunning. (humboldtii 'Fortuna x warszewiczianum) Large plants.</i>

	Phalaenopsis mannii v black	BS	40	<i>Stunning stellate light yellow flowers with black markings. Miniature plant size</i>

	Phalaenopsis bellina 'Red Apple'	BS	45	<i>Summer blooming starry cream flowers with red flush centrally. Very fragrant.</i>
	Phalaenopsis violacea f. indigo 'HP Norton'	BS	60	<i>Deep blue version of this fragrant species. Some presently in flower.</i>

	Dracula simia	BS	60	<i>The flower that was originally dubbed the monkey flower on line. Striking, large chocolate flowers.</i>
	Dracula vampira	BS	65	<i>Huge black flowers with monkey faces</i>
	Pleurothallis niviglobula	BS	30	<i>Minatare with tiny white flowers that give the appearance of speckled snow over the green leaves. Does great in a terrarium</i>
	Pleurothallis palliolata 'Bryon' HCC/AOS	BS	30	<i>Lovely heart-shaped leaves that continue producing gold and red cockle shell shaped flowers</i>
	Pleurothallis palliolata 'Eichenfels'	BS	25	<i>Pink clam shells on heart shaped leaves. We grow this because we love the shape of the leaves</i>
	Pleurothallis scuerula	BS	30	<i>Elongated heart-shaped leaves with pulpit shaped cream flowers</i>
	Pleurothallis sp 'Burning sands'	BS	25	<i>Mahogany flowers .Vigorous grower.</i>
	Scaphosepalum digitale	BS	30	<i>Mature plants are very small, forming little tufts. Dark pink flowers. Intermediate temperatures.</i>

	Specklinia gracillium	BS	35	<i>Miniature, tufted, plants that produce long inflorescences with lots of translucent green flowers</i>
	Specklinia picta 'Gigi'	BS	45	<i>This a great species that quickly grows into a cushion of leaves. This is the rare red form that is usually light yellow.</i>
