This list replaces & supersedes all previous lists. All orders are removed from sale in the order in which they are received (if your order is reserved with a credit card) & are subject to prior sale.

We only ship to the continental US (not Hawaii or Alaska) so prices are listed in US Dollars.

PHALAENOPSIS Categories are divided into:

Species, Multi-Floral Minis, Super-Minis, Pelorics, 'BIG LIP' hybrids & Waxy (often Fragrant) Novelties

Other categories include **MINIATURE VANDACEOUS, MINIATURE DENDROBIUMS** & divisions of some of our select **PAPHS, MINIATURE/COMPACT (TETRAPLOID) CATTLEYAS** and **MISCELLANEOUS GENERA** ~ all of which grow & flower happily with our Phals. Each genus is put into their own category following our Phal. lists.

Most plants are in 2.5-3" pots as first or second bloomers with a few new Stem Props being in 1.7" pots, Near Blooming to Blooming Size. The bulk of our stock is currently growing in New Zealand moss unless otherwise noted.

OF SPECIAL NOTE: *We will repot anything, immediately upon arrival from Taiwan, into the proper size pot if needed for its root system (this often means a smaller pot) & in the best grade of New Zealand moss available to give it the perfect jump-start for our more challenged US (as opposed to the perfect Taiwanese) growing conditions !*

ORDERING INFORMATION FOR OUR MAIL ORDER CLIENTS:

During winter or summer temperature extremes, shipments may be delayed pending more moderate weather conditions.

We now use UPS Ground or Air depending on the final destination. We will not ship via Priority Mail at this point.

We reserve the right to withdraw any offering from sale and to limit quantities. We guarantee all plants to be true to their identity to the best of our knowledge. However, since many come in from Taiwan, we have to assume they are properly labeled as to their species or hybrid name. We make no warranty as to the productiveness of any plants sold since everyone's growing conditions vary.

Although we do our utmost to pack carefully, we are not responsible for damage to buds or flowers if buyer specifically requests these plants ~ therefore, risk is assumed by buyer for buds or flowers shipped at this stage since factors beyond our control can contribute to flower or spike damage in transit. Safe arrival of a healthy orchid plant is guaranteed.

Packing & Shipping Charges:

A Packing Charge of a maximum of 10% of your order total, plus the actual UPS Shipping Cost, will be added to your invoice.

We use UPS Ground for most 1-2 day deliveries within reasonable delivery zones since Ground rates are much more reasonable & direct than sending them via UPS Air.

UPS is now our #1 preferred shipper for Air & Ground shipping since they're much more reliable than FedEx Delivery has recently been. If you prefer FedEx for shipping, we will not be responsible for cold or heat damage to the plants, nor for shipping delays or lack of accurate tracking information.

Distances greater than a 2-day Ground delivery in winter or summer extremes will be sent via UPS 2nd Day Air.

If a heat pack is needed during the winter, it will be included for an additional \$3.50.

Additional Shipping Notes: If you prefer **FedEx**, they do add a surcharge of \$3.50 for "Home Delivery" so many of our clients choose to have their plants delivered either to their office or to a nearby FedEx location that accepts "Hold for Pickup" packages.

During the coldest/hottest months, we will **only** ship to FedEx "Hold for Pickup" or Business locations.

This way your package is not exposed to being on the delivery vehicle for too long since Business or "Hold for Pickup" addresses get Priority Delivery, often before noon.

We will gladly research a location near you that accepts "Hold for Pickup" Ground or Express packages.

GIFT CERTIFICATES:

We also have attractive **Orchid Gift Certificates** for any denomination, which can either be emailed directly to the recipient or sent by snail mail with an Angela Mirro note card so you can include it with your own special greeting.

This is the perfect answer for those who are reluctant to send gift plants during extreme weather conditions.

Just let us know the amount, the recipient's name & how you would like it to be sent ~ each certificate is good for 6 months from the date of purchase.

NOTE: Your credit card will **not** be charged until your order is packed & ready to ship since carrier shipping charges vary based on box size & destination zip code. We accept all major credit/debit cards (**not PayPal**) for mail orders ~ your card information is never saved on our computer so it's 100% protected from fraud via our secure Card Processor.

Once your order is packed for shipping you will receive 3 separate confirmation emails:

SIZE DEFINITIONS:

- B/F** = Currently in bud and/or in flower (one spike unless otherwise noted)
- B** = In bud (one spike unless otherwise noted)
- SP** = In spike, just initiating to pre-bud stage (one spike unless otherwise noted)
- BS or PF/BS** = Blooming size (BS) or Previously flowered (PF/BS) ~ should flower again in season
- NBS/BS** = Near blooming to blooming size (approximately 6-12 months to flowering, depending on your growing conditions)
- S** = about 2-3 years to first flowering

Please Note: Since our stock quantities are constantly changing due to the current abundance of mail orders, we are no longer noting quantities available on most stock, unless very limited, since it can vary from one day to the next. In case we are sold out of an orchid you might want, we can always suggest a substitute of something very similar.

PHAL SPECIES:

Most of our Phalaenopsis species are from Taiwan & reflect much improved forms & colors, having been sibbed or selfed using very select new generation parents. Species like Phal. bellina, violacea, venosa, amboinensis, speciosa, gigantea, viridis and javanica are extremely slow to reach maturity & can be easily lost as small seedlings so we're only offering well-established Near Blooming or Blooming Size plants. As a result of their extra years to reach maturity, the pricing on these plants is higher than is usual for the quicker growing & more readily available Phal. species.

Further enhanced with a central white heart & lip, its 5.7cm waxy flowers are also fragrant. A novelty species in the background of today's cutting edge breeding, it can produce four or more flowers on each inflorescence ~ a fully mature plant will show off with multiple spikes just exploding with its bold patterning. Previously flowered spikes will remain green & continue to add additional buds & spikes in season. 	<p>Phal. aphrodite subsp. formosana 'A09001' (4N) <i>(TETRAPLOID FORM of Species)</i></p> <p><i>A dynamite tetraploid form of this classic form of all Phal. species ! This 4N clone is producing more compact rounder leaves and much larger flowers than is typical for this subspecies of aphrodite (previously known as Phal. amabilis). Its fuller form & beautifully round flowers with the petals almost touching carries heavy substance & produces a much longer-lasting display with a smaller leaf span than is typical for this species. And the bonus to this particular 4N strain is their naturally & gracefully cascading spikes with the flowers displayed to absolute perfection, creating a stunning display !</i></p> <p>WINNER OF IPA BEST PHAL IN SHOW TROPHY !</p>	<p>PF/BS (2)</p>	<p>\$ 48</p>

Its barring isn't quite as broad which allows a greater contrast between the red bars & its golden yellow background. This cerulean strain has a blue flush which, along with its dark lavender-blue lip, makes quite a statement. Light & temperature at the time of bud formation can influence the intensity of its blue flush from one flower to the next on the same spike. This species will continue to flower on older inflorescences in addition to producing new. 	<p>Phal. japonica 'Super Star' x sib <i>(Species ~ formerly Sedirea japonica)</i></p> <p><i>Endemic to Japan, this miniature wonder will captivate you with its sweet lemony fragrance ! A spring to summer bloomer, it can produce up to ten 1.2" flowers on each 7" spike ~ once fully mature its spikes will branch readily, & it can produce a multitude of spikes, with all in flower at the same time. Formerly a member of the Vanda family, it bears heavier substance upright leaves & it can also produce basal keikis around the mother plant creating a miniature bush of creamy white flowers bearing soft green undertones, the lateral sepals accented with purple bars & its lip outlined with purple spots. This species needs a good draining media & hates to be kept too wet so we recommend growing it in small plastic pots or baskets with NZ moss, or mounted, allowing it to dry <u>slightly</u> between waterings. After flowering, it benefits from being grown a little cooler & drier than during its active growing season, conditions much like its Vandaceous cousins prefer.</i></p> <p>FRAGRANT SUPER-MINI ! 	<p>Phal. stuartiana 'Sogo' HCC/AOS <i>(Best clone of this Species)</i></p> <p><i>Without a doubt, we feel this is still the very best clone of this species around ! Not only does it have fuller form 5.5cm flowers with distinct crisp spotting over all its segments, but its spikes can branch readily for the ultimate display. Great round compact upright-growing leaves with beautifully mottled foliage complete the picture so it's enjoyable even when not in flower. This particular species does not like to stay wet for too long so we always suggest waiting until it's almost dry to water again. We've also found, under our growing conditions, that it does better under slightly lower light than the typical Phalaenopsis, possibly due to its mottled foliage. 	<p>Phal. tetraspis fma. brunneola 'Wilson Coffee #1' <i>(Select clone of Species)</i></p> <p><i>We first saw a plant of this variety of Phal. tetraspis several years ago at the TIOS Show in Taiwan & were struck with its unusual color & floriferousness for the species ! Its pleasantly full café au lait 4.3cm flowers can be produced in abundance on compact branching spikes in season, and previously flowered spikes often remain green, continuing to add additional buds & flowers while still producing new spikes. Like the clone 'C#1' of tetraspis, no two flowers will be identical, leading to a new surprise with each opened bud. As we do with all forms of tetraspis (speciosa), we give this clone slightly lower light than a standard Phalaenopsis & keep it evenly moist year 'round, without being sopping wet, following the same growing conditions it experiences in nature in the Philippines & Nicobar Islands !</i></p> <p><i>NOTE: We've already flowered a couple of plants of this clone, 'Coffee', & they are exceptional for their fuller form & perfectly flat flowers. Photos posted on FB & the internet show very poor clones of other plants of this species with crumpled flowers & poor color.  <p><i>This is an actual photo of our plant when it flowered in April ! Its fuller form & the green influence really comes out when flowered under shadier & cooler conditions.</i></p>	<p>Phal. tetraspis 'Green' <i>(Green tipped form of Species)</i></p> <p><i>We sold out of these the minute we posted them two years ago ~ and we just obtained a few more to share ! We've observed that when flowered in the heat of the warmer months, its green influence is not as strong as when it's grown under brighter & cooler conditions ~ in the warmer summer months we grow it a little shadier & cooler to enhance its green influence. Previously flowered spikes will stay green so don't remove them but allow them to continue to produce additional flowers in season while still creating new flower spikes. We've also found that this particular color form of the species improves as the plants mature ~ a worthy addition to every collection !</i></p> <p>FRAGRANT ! Every one we've flowered so far has been solid red so it has proven to be a very stable clone of this color form. 	<p>Phal. tetraspis (speciosa) coerulea 'Wilson' (Blue clone of Species)</p> <p><i>We suspect that this particular clone is actually the same as our previously listed Phal. tetraspis fma. livida 'Yaphon', also listed by others as speciosa 'L-26' ! Often mericlones are released by a nursery without a particular clonal name, so the nursery that purchases them for resale will put their own clonal name on the plants. It's very possible that all the variously named clones of this blue form of the species are one & the same. Or it could be the grey-blue color form of the species. Often mericlones are released by a nursery without a particular clonal name, so the nursery that purchases them for resale will put their own clonal name on the plants. It's possible that all the variously named clones of this blue form of the species are one & the same or variations of the 'L-26' clone. But until we've flowered them we cannot be sure of this. 	<p>Phal. violacea fma. indigo 'M' (Select Stem Prop of Species)</p> <p>An exciting just-released Stem Prop of the Indigo form which was achieved as a result of years of sibbing & selfing select strains of Phal. violacea fma. indigo ! This intensely colored clone, producing wonderfully full form flowers, is the result of a careful selection of its parents for their increased vigor and robust root systems & building on HP Norton & Krull Smith's original strains of Indigo violaceas. Beautiful richly colored fragrant flowers become their most intense indigo color in slightly cooler & brighter conditions in the spring & fall. 	<p>Phal. zebrina (Sib cross of Palawan form of Species)</p> <p>Endemic to Myanmar, Thailand, Borneo & Sumatra, this rarely available & fragrant warm growing waxy species flowers from spring into the summer ! We've already flowered a couple from this sib cross & their flower size & crisp well-defined marks have been sensational. This species carries horizontal to erect 4+” long spikes, producing over five 1 ½-2” waxy flowers. Light & temperature during bud/flower formation can affect the intensity & abundance of its marks, varying according to its particular bloom season. We've also found that they grow better for us under more moderate light than is typical for the average Phalaenopsis. PHALAENOPSIS HYBRIDS

Most of these clones are the result of cutting-edge Taiwanese breeding programs & are plants we've selected from some of the most forward-thinking nurseries during our annual trips to Taiwan to judge their Orchid Shows.

Many of the hybrids with a heavy Harlequin influence or red, yellow or orange in their breeding background will show their boldest and most vivid colors when bloomed under cooler temperatures & brighter light during the fall & winter.

MULTI-FLORAL MINIS & MULTI-FLORAL MIDIS (including Harlequins & Splash-Petals):

Much to our amazement, many of our Minis & Midis have already spiked again for the second time within 6 months ! Their tendency to flower more frequently is due in large part to today's select breeding using more vigorous cutting-edge parents.

**** We're defining "MULTI-FLORAL MIDI" as those that produce flowers that are around 2 ½" to 3" in size, halfway between a typical mini & a larger flowering classic with their flower size being influenced by a parent of each size.*





'BIG LIP' HYBRIDS:

One of the most important factors in today's 'Big Lip' breeding is a large flat lip that is almost identical to the petals ! We have seen some pretty poor hybrids in this new line of breeding over the past 2-3 years, with their 'big lips' either cupped or crippled, or with the "lip" dropping so far down from the other segments of the flower that you could drive a truck right through it ! The clones we choose to carry must have a beautiful broad flat lip tucked right up into the flower itself so it gives the definite impression of a 3-petal ~ or 3-lip ~ flower. There have been only a few so far that meet those standards for us, & we're excited to be able to share some of them with everyone.




Many have been bred from smaller growing and flowering Phalaenopsis species like Phal. lobbii, parishii & pulcherrima ~ and they usually flower more than once a year, with many from this line of breeding continuing to add additional buds & flowers on previously bloomed spikes while still creating an additional new spike or more. Some also readily produce keikis (baby plants) from their base or on a spike, or both, to create the ultimate flowering presentation.

These are not often available to us in the US, but one of our nurseries is always on the look-out for them with us in mind, hand-selecting them while in flower to assure their peloric result. 

As mentioned under Phal. species, due to the heavy influence of the slower-growing species of Phal. bellina, violacea, lueddemanniana, amboinensis & venosa in their breeding backgrounds, it often takes an additional year or two for these hybrids to reach flowering size as opposed to a standard Phalaenopsis. But once they do, they're well worth the wait for their vivid color, thick long-lasting waxy flowers & amazing fragrances. Plus, many of these Novelty-type hybrids improve even more in their color intensity and size while adding fuller form on their 2nd & 3^d flowerings. They will often retain previously flowered green spikes, continuing to add more buds to them, while still producing additional spikes ~ within a couple of years these plants can be surrounded with multiple spikes in full flower for a sensational show to please all the senses !



OTHER GENERA WHICH GROW & FLOWER EASILY UNDER PHALAEOPSIS CONDITIONS

MINIATURE VANDACEOUS:

All these species & hybrids grow & flower easily WITH our Phals under the same light & temperature conditions since they are miniature growers, requiring much lower light than their larger-growing & flowering cousins. We're growing them in small plastic baskets, with just a little media in the bottom of each basket, to allow their roots to dry slightly between waterings. We then rest the rims of these little baskets onto the rims of deep rose pots, allowing the roots to continue to grow down from the basket into the empty bottom of the rose pot which retains a lot of humidity. This is our own approach to the growing method of "collaring" which the Vandaceous seem to love. These are mostly miniature ~ with a few compact-growing ~ species & hybrids, many of which will readily form basal keikis to become beautiful specimen miniatures producing multitudes of spikes at the same time on all of their mature growths. And many of them are also delightfully FRAGRANT !



OTHER GENERA ~ ONCIDINAE, MISC SPECIES & HYBRIDS ~ MINIATURES & STANDARDS:

All the plants listed below grow & flower easily WITH our Phals under the same light & temperature conditions since many are miniature growing species or hybrids, requiring much lower light than their larger cousins – they can put on quite a show for their compact size ! In addition, Oncidinae can also be grown under intermediate conditions with bright Phalaenopsis light.

As a side note, all the Oncidinae are growing in New Zealand moss which they seem to love ~ we never would have believed they would do so beautifully in this medium ! The moss not only helps maintain a nice even moisture in the pot, but it also helps the plant retain plumper pseudobulbs while adding to the vigor of the plant's new growths. We've been amazed at the difference the moss makes for all these plants as opposed to growing them in a bark mix.

As you will see, we're extremely fond of the Brassia-type Oncidinae from this section of the Oncidium family, choosing to carry many of its hybrids, both miniatures and standards, for their truly exotic displays of long-lasting waxy fragrant flowers ~ they simply redefine the word "exotic" for us.

The leaves will drop in the fall after flowering, at which point we slightly reduce watering & fertilizing through the winter, but we do recommend keeping the medium damp to avoid shriveling its pseudobulbs. With the onset of new growth in the spring, we resume normal watering/fertilizing. Its heavy chocolate barring only varies with the light and temperature conditions (cooler & brighter versus warmer & shadier) when the spikes are forming.
