We only ship to the continental US (not Hawaii or Alaska) so prices are listed in US Dollars.

PHALAENOPSIS are separated into their own groups of:

Species, Multi-Floral Minis, Super-Minis, Pelorics, 'BIG LIPS', Waxy Novelties, One-of-a-Kind Cutting-Edge Novelty Seedlings

Other categories include **MINIATURE VANDACEOUS**, **MINIATURE DENDROBIUMS** & divisions of some of our select **PAPHS**, **MINIATURE/COMPACT (TETRAPLOID) CATTLEYAS** and **MISCELLANEOUS GENERA** ~ all of which grow & flower happily with our Phals. Each genus is put into their own category following our Phal. lists.

NEW WITH THIS LIST !: Beginning on page 50 of this list is a Preview of what has just arrived or is arriving from Taiwan in May ~ available now for Pre-Order Reservations.

Some of these plants came in bare root (these are noted as such) & have just been potted up, not established yet. In making a "Pre-Order Reservation" no commitment is implied until the plants are priced & you confirm the order ~ but it does guarantee you first pick, especially if the stock is limited.

We plan to begin shipping plants from this group the end of May or the beginning to mid-June. Prices are yet to be determined, pending the ongoing & outrageously increased costs for shipping & broker fees.

NOTE: Many of our plants are in 2.5-3" pots as first or second bloomers with a few new Stem Props & Seedlings in 1.7" pots, At Near Blooming to Blooming Size. The bulk of our stock is currently growing in New Zealand moss unless otherwise noted.

OF SPECIAL NOTE: *We do selectively repot some plants, immediately upon arrival from Taiwan, into the proper size pot for their root systems (this often means a smaller pot) & in the best grade of New Zealand moss available (One Mile Moss) to give them the perfect jump-start for our more challenged US (as opposed to the perfect Taiwan) growing conditions !*

ORDERING INFORMATION FOR OUR MAIL ORDER CLIENTS:

During temperature extremes, we may delay shipping pending more moderate weather conditions.

We now use UPS Ground or Air depending on the final destination. We will not ship via Priority Mail at this point.

We reserve the right to withdraw any offering from sale and to limit quantities. We guarantee all plants to be true to their identity to the best of our knowledge. However, since many come in from Taiwan, we have to assume they are properly labeled as to their species or hybrid name. We make no warranty as to the productiveness of any plants sold since everyone's growing conditions vary.

Although we do our utmost to pack carefully, we are not responsible for damage to buds or flowers if buyer specifically requests these plants ~ therefore, risk is assumed by buyer for buds or flowers shipped at this stage since factors beyond our control can contribute to flower or spike damage in transit. Safe arrival of a healthy orchid plant is guaranteed.

Packing & Shipping Charges:

A Packing Charge of a maximum of 10% of your order total, plus the actual UPS Shipping Cost, will be added to your invoice.

We use UPS Ground for most 1-2 day deliveries within reasonable delivery zones since

Ground rates are much more reasonable & direct than sending them via UPS Air.

Be aware that no carrier, neither UPS, FedEx or USPS will be responsible for damage to perishables (meaning plants), even if they're carrying added insurance. This may cause us to hold shipping your order until the weather improves.

UPS is now our #1 preferred shipper for Air & Ground shipping since they're much more reliable than FedEx Delivery has recently been. If you prefer FedEx for shipping, we will not be responsible for shipping delays or lack of accurate/updated tracking information.

Distances greater than a 2-day Ground delivery in winter or summer extremes will be sent via UPS 2nd Day Air.

If a heat pack is needed during the winter, it will be included for an additional \$3.50.

Additional Shipping Notes: If you prefer **FedEx**, shipping is at your risk. They do add a surcharge of \$3.50 for "Home Delivery" so many of our clients choose to have their plants delivered either to their office or to a nearby FedEx location that accepts "Hold for Pickup" packages. During the coldest/hottest months, we will **only** ship to FedEx "Hold for Pickup" or Business locations.

This way your package is not exposed to being on the delivery vehicle for too long since Business or "Hold for Pickup" addresses get Priority Delivery, often before noon.

We will gladly research a location near you that accepts "Hold for Pickup" Ground or Express packages.

GIFT CERTIFICATES:

We also have attractive **Orchid Gift Certificates** for any denomination, which can either be emailed directly to the recipient or sent by snail mail with an Angela Mirro note card so you can include it with your own special greeting. This is the perfect answer for those who are reluctant to send gift plants during extreme weather conditions. Just let us know the amount, the recipient's name & how you would like it to be sent ~ each certificate is good for 6 months from the date of purchase.

As soon as we've confirmed receipt of your order via return email, call us at **(203) 329-7255** with your credit card info. For those clients who ask us to hold a shipment beyond a reasonable delivery time-frame, we need a **non-refundable** deposit of 50% of that order total.

3 ~ Once we have all that information we will tag & remove your orchids from sale, then arrange a convenient shipping date.

NOTE: Your credit card will **not** be charged until your order is packed & ready to ship since carrier shipping charges vary based on box size & destination zip code. We accept all major credit/debit cards (**not PayPal**) for mail orders ~ your card information is never saved on our computer so it's 100% protected from fraud via our secure Card Processor.

Once your order is packed for shipping you will receive 3 separate confirmation emails:

- 1** ~ Your actual Credit Card Receipt
- 2** ~ Your shipping Tracking Number
- 3** ~ A detailed orchidPhile Receipt for your purchase

SIZE DEFINITIONS:

B/F = Currently in bud and/or in flower (one spike unless otherwise noted)

B = In bud (one spike unless otherwise noted)

SP = In spike, just initiating to pre-bud stage (one spike unless otherwise noted)

BS or PF/BS = Blooming size (BS) or Previously flowered (PF/BS) ~ should flower again in season

NBS/BS = Near blooming to blooming size (approximately 6-12 months to flowering, depending on your growing conditions)

S = about 2-3 years to first flowering

Please Note: Since our stock quantities are constantly changing due to the current abundance of mail orders, we are no longer noting quantities available on stock, unless very limited, since it can vary from one day to the next. In case we are sold out of an orchid you might want, we can always suggest a substitute of something very similar.

AN IMPORTANT NOTE RE: LARGER POT SIZES POSTED ON VARIOUS ORCHID WEBSITES:

Don't be misled by pot sizes noted on various orchid websites, especially when the plants are coming from the same Taiwan nursery/grower ~ a larger pot doesn't mean a larger or more mature plant! Often plants from Taiwan arrive in larger pots with large leaf spans, but with fewer roots due to Taiwan's perfect growing conditions. And sometimes the moss is beginning to break down or is not of the best quality for vigorous growth. This is not ideal for our more challenged US growing conditions ~ here their root systems often benefit from being in a smaller pot in the best quality moss, extremely important when they're growing in the more moisture-retentive NZ moss.

Since many come from the same nurseries, their leaf spans are identical for us all, no matter what pot size is listed ~ some growers choose to "flip" (list & ship) them right away in the pot size they arrived in. We prefer to see the roots breaking out to, or robustly encircling, the sides of the pot which is an indication that it's well established in that pot.

All too often you'll see no roots around the sides of a pot while all the roots in the center have rotted due to a lesser quality, shorter-lived, & more acidic NZ moss that has already broken down, smothering them as a result.

Because of this, we will often choose to reduce the pot size slightly by selectively repotting some of these plants, based on the vigor of their root system, into a smaller pot with premiere top quality NZ moss to avoid any root rot that could result from staying too wet for too long in too large a pot. We make this additional effort to assure everyone of a healthy, properly potted plant that they can continue to grow on without concern or the urgent need to repot it.

The fastest way to lose your orchid is by growing it in too large a pot or in a "lesser-than-top-grade" NZ moss ~ both conditions can lead to root loss with the plant declining & eventually being totally lost! If purchased elsewhere, our suggestion is to consider repotting your plant as soon as possible to avoid root loss due to media breakdown, especially if the plant has been shifted from its plug size pot with its older media still intact around the roots into a larger pot.

PHAL SPECIES:

Most of our Phalaenopsis species are from Taiwan & reflect much improved forms & colors, having been sibbed or selfed, using very select new generation parents. Species like Phal. bellina, violacea, venosa, amboinensis, speciosa, gigantea, viridis and javanica are extremely slow to reach maturity & can be easily lost as small seedlings so we're only offering well-established Near Blooming to Blooming Size plants. As a result of their extra years to reach maturity, the pricing on these plants is higher than is usual for the quicker growing & more readily available Phal. species.

The 5.7cm waxy fragrant flowers will cascade gracefully over the leaves, producing four or more flowers on each inflorescence ~ a fully mature plant can show off with multiple spikes just exploding with bold patterning. Previously flowered spikes will remain green & continue to add additional buds & spikes in season. It's very possible that all the variously named clones of this blue form of the species are one & the same. Or it could be the grey-blue color form of the species ~ or from some photos we've seen, a result of the brown (brunneola) color form with the blue color form. Often mericlones are released by a nursery without a particular clonal name, so the nursery that purchases them for resale will put their own clonal name on the plants. But until we've flowered them we cannot be sure of this. Several of these have already flowered for us & they are a wonderful dark cerulean blue which the camera never seems to capture accurately. As an interesting side note, we've re-flowered several that bloomed in the warmer long-day months which flowered solid blue. But with the short winter days & cooler temperatures, we've seen them throw the odd white segment on what previously flowered as a solid blue flower. No matter which way they flower, they produce great compact spikes over an equally compact leaf span. 	<p align="center">Phal. zebrina (Sib cross of Palawan form of Species)</p> <p><i>Endemic to Myanmar, Thailand, Borneo & Sumatra, this rarely available & fragrant warm growing waxy species flowers from spring into the summer ! We've already flowered a couple from this sib cross & their flower size & crisp well-defined marks have been sensational. This species carries horizontal to erect 4+'' long spikes, producing over five 1 ½-2'' waxy flowers. Light & temperature during bud/flower formation can affect the intensity & abundance of its marks, varying according to its particular bloom season. We've also found that they grow better for us under more moderate light than is typical for the average Phalaenopsis. PHALAENOPSIS HYBRIDS

Most of these clones are the result of cutting-edge Taiwanese breeding programs & are plants we've selected from some of the most forward-thinking nurseries during our annual trips to Taiwan to judge their Orchid Shows.

Many of the hybrids with a heavy Harlequin influence or red, yellow or orange in their breeding background will show their boldest and most vivid colors when bloomed under cooler temperatures & brighter light during the fall & winter.

MULTI-FLORAL MINIS & MULTI-FLORAL MIDIS (including Novelties, Harlequins & Splash-Petals):

Much to our amazement, many of our Minis & Midis have already spiked again for the second time within 6 months ! Their tendency to flower more frequently is due in large part to today's select breeding using more vigorous cutting-edge parents.

**** We're defining "MULTI-FLORAL MIDI" as those that produce flowers that are around 2 ½" to 3" in size, halfway between a typical mini & a larger flowering classic with their flower size being influenced by a parent of each size.*



One of the most important factors in today's 'Big Lip' breeding is a large flat lip that is almost identical to the petals ! We have seen some pretty poor hybrids in this new line of breeding over the past 2-5 years, with their 'big lips' either cupped or crippled, or with the "lip" dropping so far down from the other segments of the flower that you could drive a truck right through it ! The clones we choose to carry must have a beautiful broad flat lip tucked right up into the flower itself so it gives the definite impression of a 3-petal ~ or 3-lip ~ flower. There have been only a few so far that meet those standards for us, & we're excited to be able to share some of them with everyone.

As mentioned under Phal. species, due to the heavy influence of the slower-growing species of Phal. bellina, violacea, lueddemanniana, amboinensis & venosa in their breeding backgrounds, it often takes an additional year or two for these hybrids to reach flowering size as opposed to a standard Phalaenopsis. But once they do, they're well worth the wait for their vivid color, thick long-lasting waxy flowers & amazing FRAGRANCE. Plus, many of these Novelty-type hybrids improve even more in their color intensity and size while adding fuller form on their 2nd & 3^d flowerings. They will often retain previously flowered green spikes, continuing to add more buds to them, while still producing additional spikes ~ within a couple of years these plants can be surrounded with multiple spikes in full flower for a sensational show to please all the senses !

OF SPECIAL NOTE: *With many of the blue, red or orange novelties, differences in light & temperature at various times of the year can cause some variation in the flower color and/or the intensity of their markings.*





OTHER GENERA WHICH GROW & FLOWER READILY UNDER PHALAENOPSIS CONDITIONS

MINIATURE VANDACEOUS:

All these species & hybrids grow & flower easily WITH our Phals under the same light & temperature conditions since they are miniature growers, requiring much lower light than their larger-growing & flowering cousins. We're growing them in small plastic baskets, with just a little media in the bottom of each basket, to allow their roots to dry slightly between waterings. We then rest the rims of these little baskets onto the rims of deep rose pots, allowing the roots to continue to grow down from the basket into the empty bottom of the rose pot which retains a lot of humidity. This is our own approach to the growing method of "collaring" which the Vandaceous seem to love. These are mostly miniature ~ with a few compact-growing ~ species & hybrids, many of which will readily form basal keikis to become beautiful specimen miniatures producing multitudes of spikes at the same time on all of their mature growths. And many of them are also delightfully FRAGRANT !







As a side note, all the Oncidinae are growing in New Zealand moss which they seem to love ~ we never would have believed they would do so beautifully in this medium ! The moss not only helps maintain a nice even moisture in the pot, but it also helps the plant retain plumper pseudobulbs while adding to the vigor of the plant's new growths. We've been amazed at the difference the moss makes for all these plants as opposed to growing them in a bark mix.

They can flower any time of the year in response to the onset of new growths, often bearing 2 or more spikes per growth, & we've had several flower again within just two months so they have no particular flowering season ! They will grow equally well under intermediate temperatures although we grow them just a bit warmer with our Phalaenopsis. Light & temperature at bud/flowering can affect color & flatness of its flowers slightly ~ fall/winter flowering always produces the best flowers.
